Dear Room 309 Parents:

We are close to the end of the semester, and with that I have been giving the students some reminders. **Community Service forms are due Tuesday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>** (the last day of first semester). This is part of every student's Bible class grade, so please encourage your kids to complete the forms. It means report cards will be coming home before too long. It also means that starting on Wednesday the 24<sup>th</sup>, students start with a "clean slate", grade-wise. If he or she has been struggling with missing or late assignments, it's a chance to start over fresh.

Another thing I shared with my class is that the Mariner's game field trip in May is contingent upon their grades. Our third grading period ends on March 29. Students who do not have at least a 70% in each class will not be able to come to the Mariner's game – it is an earned privilege. We do this every year, partly because we find that the late winter/early spring time is the time when a lot of students begin to "ease up" on their effort, and this helps give them an incentive to keep working hard.

I still need one more chaperone for the Pacific Science Center field trip on February 8<sup>th</sup>. Please let me know if you can join us! Remember, you can use these hours for your stewardship hours.

Next week on **Thursday the 25<sup>th</sup> we are having our first Junior High Night of the year!** CCA junior high students can come to the gym, have pizza, play games, and hang out! I hope everyone can come! **At the same time (6-7 pm), there will be an**

**informational meeting for parents about Northwest Christian High School.** It will be in the Career Center at NCHS. It's a good opportunity to ask any questions you have about the high school.

**Next week in academics:** In Bible we are reading and learning in John 6. U.S. History is studying the Second Great Awakening and American society and culture in the decade or two leading up to the Civil War. In Language Arts there will be a Wordly Wise test on Monday the 22<sup>nd</sup>, and we will begin literature circles and reading several books (each group reading a different novel). All of them are set during the Civil War. PNWH class will transform into Writer's Workshop, a time to practice our creative writing skills. **Starting on January 29<sup>th</sup> for both 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade Language Arts, the expectation for weekly reading minutes will move up from 150 minutes a week to 175 minutes a week.** This averages out to 25 minutes a day, which is only about 4.5 minutes more per day than the 150 minutes a week that has been expected so far.
